I. Seneschal (Roxanne – interim/Antonia - Deputy)

a) Social Media (Tofa)

- i) Myrgan Wood's social media continues to see active practice posts - moving forwards, I am seeking a deputy (either with intent to take over my position in the long run, or not) as I have taken on the role of Kingdom social media officer and would like to see some change to how Avacal as a whole views the usage of official social media platforms.
- ii) Views and interactions on our official Facebook page are down 58% compared to previous month. This is likely on account of the reduction in posts calling for members to comment offering volunteering for demos and events. On the other hand, direct messages are up a staggering 100% - and all from new prospective members. We have 17 new followers as well.
- iii) Members can help to boost our visibility by interacting with our posts - even just a "like" helps to tell the algorithm that people like our content, which will lead to Facebook showing the posts to more people.
- iv) Please consider reaching out to myself, the baronage, or the seneschal if you're interested in helping out with Myrgan Wood's social media presence - we can reach a lot of new potential players and community members if we start to engage with social media in more ways.
- v) In addition - if you take event photos, or photos of your works and projects, please consider filling out the media release forms available on the sca official website! The changes that I would like to see happen will rely on having a more steady flow of images and short video clips in order to show off who we are and what we do. - iii) The Board of Directors is currently considering the following proposed changes to Corporate Policy and invites commentary from the membership and participants.
 1. "Execution of the *Confidentiality and Responsible Information Use Agreement* by Royal Heirs
 2. Each competitor and prospective consort in a Royal List must be prepared to execute the *Confidentiality and Responsible Information Use Agreement*, hereafter referred to as "the agreement", should they be victorious. Within ten business days after being declared victor in a Crown or Coronet Tourney, the Victor and Consort must individually execute the agreement and present it to the Kingdom Seneschal, unless they have previously executed the agreement within the last ten years. The Kingdom Seneschal shall confirm to the Society Seneschal by email that the Royal Heirs have executed the agreement at their earliest convenience and shall send the properly executed agreement to the corporate office within 10 business days."

The objectives will be to host the appropriate tourney and champion events, at a camping venue, with a relaxed atmosphere. Benefits include 20 min drive to local shopping and hotels in Saskatoon. A large, semi-private green space with room for period and modern camping. Modern washrooms and showers, A large gathering site with firepit and free firewood. Setup would be Friday, with Arrivals starting Friday evening and Saturday morning. Events can be planned Saturday and Sunday with take down completed by 3pm.

J. Other Business

a) MWITS (Tonegawa no Keiran)

- i) I'm waiting to hear back from the treasurer at Bowbusters on cost and procedure, but our last correspondence on Friday came across as very positive for having event space available for Sunday, November 9th.
- ii) Plan is to book Bowbusters from noon-4 on the Sunday after Coronation to host an MWIT tournament. There will be a cost for the rental space, but I don't have that number yet.
- iii) Previous MWITs had a \$5 participation charge, and we came across in the positive numbers.
 - 1. I can cover rental fees and coordinate with the financial committee when more information is available.
- iv) Kaen Yukimura has shown interest in running the format. We'll need prizes (hoping to hit up our new A&S champ to wrangle the community with that), marshals and gate volunteers. There is an existing MWIT committee for planning, and anyone further interested in helping out should reach out to me or Robert Boniface, or honestly, any of the archers to get in on the planning.
- v) I've also tentatively sought out some Sundays in December (7th or 14th) and late January (18th or 25th) for future MWITs.
- vi) I'll update the website as we get some concrete plans in motion.
- vii) \$60 for a 4 hour exclusive use booking. At \$5/archer this breaks even at 12 attendees

b) Taverns

- i) If we want to have a holiday tavern somebody will need to step up to offer to organize it. Previous years' organizers will not be able to this year. This is a great way to try out organizing something that isn't a full event, and is even somewhat less work than a demo.
- ii) Taverns can be a community building thing, informal tavern nights can happen occasionally through the year.
