Meeting Called to Order at: 19:09

Land acknowledgement (Roxanne Delaroche): Acknowledgement of history and relationships. At the FSIN meeting today, the vice chief spoke about the chiefs who spoke to his majesty of England in London. Part of their purpose was to invite his majesty Charles to the 150 year commemoration of Treaty 6 – speaker paused and said he triggered himself after saying it was a celebration of the 150 years. Signing treaties has not been good for all parties who are part of those treaties- we should reflect on this and redouble our efforts going forwards.

Words from Their Excellencies – Amya and Alexios:

A. Exchequer (Hoshikawa Takakage)

We currently have \$38,000.31 in the account with \$5,004.60 in outstanding cheques that need to be cashed for a working balance of \$32,995.71. Skald the hall cheques will be going out this week. I am also looking for approximately \$150 for printer ink, paper, some duo tangs and postage stamps. I have priced it out and it should be less than that but I don't want to ask for more. With the help of my wonderful wife have gone through all of the files and have sorted them.
- b) We seem to be doing well, money coming in and out. 37,000\$ as of today.
- c) New cheque was cut for Bordergate as they lost the original.
- d) Deputy could step in for the financial committee for supplies for the office. Roxanne moves that we give supply money, Ayame seconds.

C. Chatelaine (Illcum the Humblewitch)

- a) Demos/ Recruiting Activities: - Demo coordination talk was February 21st. It went well and there will be more posts to come. - Next big Demo is Popcon in May
- b) Does Taka need any help with the PopCon? No, some coordination with folks at Winter War this weekend to get more volunteers.
- c) - Follow up on Conan Steak night? No activity yet.
- d) - Follow up on Tofa festival of trees. Tofa will be making some more information on this, likely after she gets back from Quebec. The barony will be making/decorating a tree!
- e) - Follow up on Pride coordination; sir Korsak is now the lead
- f) Demos/ Recruiting Activities Finished: - None
- g) Newcomers/Returned Members: Morgan is going to Ferrets Feast, if folks are going maybe reach out and be welcoming. Tim has been coming out to some practices
- h) Gold Key: Goldkey will be going to TuA for those who need. Potential for old gold key tunics to be used as fight tunics for newcomers. General agreement that this would be nice.

D. Herald (Aethelbert)

- a) Since our last report, we have held an event at which several awards were bestowed. I am pleased to report that all of these awards have now been recorded in the Order of Precedence.
- b) Work on outstanding scrolls is progressing well. Plans are now in place for all outstanding scrolls with the exception of one, which is my own. Arrangements are currently being made to have that scroll completed, and I will not be informed of the artist in keeping with tradition.

- c) Looking ahead, we are seeking volunteers interested in creating a few fun, non-official scrolls to be given out at PopCon. These are intended to be lighthearted and do not need to meet formal award scroll standards, making them a great opportunity for anyone interested in trying scribal work for the first time.
- d) In addition, I will be putting out a call for both new and experienced scribes. We are looking for beginners who would like to try their hand at fun scrolls, as well as experienced scribes who may be willing to take on projects for award scrolls to be given out at Summer Championships in July and at Anniversary in October.
- e) With Their Excellencies Amya and Alexios stepping down at Anniversary, it is my goal to have all outstanding scrolls completed and presented by that time.
- f) To support this, I will also be reaching out beyond Myrgan Wood to other communities who may be able to assist. I will be coordinating with the Webminister and Social Media Officer to share this call on official channels.
- g) Tofa suggests reaching out to Kingdom Scribe for helpers, Aethelbert will check this out.

E. Chronicler (Conan of Myrgan Wood)

- a) Business is good, minutes distributed for both February business meeting and February extra meeting. Haven't heard any corrections.
- b) Robert with the newsletter, he has big scary plans, and they will be coming soon. Watch the website for updates.

F. Web Minister (Tonegawa)

- a) The website is secure and up to date (please hit me up if anyone notices anything out of date or incorrect). Baronial awards are now all listed, if you have won an award from the barony, you should see it listed on the website now. Waiting on B&B's approval for Isabelle Buckell's new design for Populace badge and an award. Hoping to get Maggie the Magpie deputized this week at Gaderian. Thanks!
- b) Merchants in Myrgan Wood, there is a place on the website, you can be listed!

- c) Also there is a showcase page for cool things in the barony, currently only Hamish's poem is in.

G. Knight Marshall (Korsak)

- a) Report from Alexios: Steady as she goes. Korsak is taking over but I've forgotten to give him the email password.
- b) Korsak has been hurt for a bit but stuff is going on. A budget has been submitted for armour improvements, and tomorrow he and Sir Kvigr are going to be going through the group gear to see what's worth keeping.
- c) Been talking to a lot of folks who have tried armoured and quit or only tried it a few times, and most of the time the reason they have stopped is the group gear being uncomfortable. Helmets especially are a pinch point.
- d) Conan brings up, if we have folks bring the group gear collectively, we can bring it easier in bulk to practices. Also, we can have the armour in possession of the more established members instead of sending it home with newbies who might forget. Korsak is up for implementing this once the new equipment gets set up.
- e) Amya chips in that we should definitely have more armour and support our armoured community.
- f) Tonegawa says the budget as is, is not that expensive considering how much we have put in to the other disciplines.
- g) Kaen, also says that 3 helmets is not very much and would help folks who even just want to do combat archery.
- h) Taka points out, it has been a long time since we have spent on armour.
- i) There is a new type of padding, Shok Tek, which might be a good direction for anti-concussion padding. It might be a good idea to put this in the newbie armour so they don't have to deal with that.
- j) Aethelbert asks, how many fighters would we have to be able to equip? Korsak estimates, 1000\$ per person ideally so about 3 fighters, with maybe more or less depending on what's in the group gear currently. One kit for smaller, medium and larger fighters.
- k) Amya asks, if there is a bunch of Shok Tek being purchased, can we order more so folks can acquire some for themselves? Korsak says potentially, shipping spikes at different weights, if we order too much it might suddenly cost a lot more. To be determined. Some of the shipping costs will be voided, Ivar can be acquired directly from him, costs from India might be included shipping. Sir Angelica down in Regina is using it and says it is fantastic.
- l) Loki would like to start doing some marshalling shadowing/training, this will be discussed at next practice.
- m) Missile Deputy (Adam)

- i) In February we had only 2 practices. One cancelled due to Bowbusters indoor 3d shoot and one due to Skald the hall. We continue to have around 2 to 3 archers and 5 thrown weapons practitioners for practice. The current setup at bowbusters is working well. We continue to improve it little bits at a time.
 - ii) Aethelbert asks if consumables are doing well (arrows, bows etc)? Adam says quite a lot of stuff is left over from last build, things seem good for now. Tonegawa notes she was just in the box, lots of group arrows and equipment. If we are looking to host archery at Quad war, may need to look into this, but just for practices it seems fine now.
- n) Thrown Deputy (Alexandra)
 - i) No new people for thrown or archery this last time, but there have been consistent showings.
 - ii) Still no response yet from last meeting about getting some supplies to improve the thrown range, can re-send if needed. 250\$ total for 4 boards to extend the backboard and a few soft targets to replace some.
 - iii) Amya notes we could do a motion to approve sending this to the financial committee, Tonegawa moves, Robert and Aethelbert second.
- o) Rapier (Basil)
 - i) Not much to report this meeting, fight practices continue as normal.
 - ii) Planning to bring the sign out sheet so that folks can take equipment with them to Winter War.

people.

- g) Kingdom Level bids
 - i) TUA 2027 – Robert Boniface
 - ii) 11% of a plan so far, not much to bring up yet.
 - iii) September 2027 – Susan and Haskul
 - iv) Not present today.
- h) Financial committee has met, and approved the thrown weapons
purchase Alexandra sent in. They would like to go over Korsak's
budget some more yet, and have not had the chance to look at
Taka's budget change. Alexandra will buy it and be reimbursed,
Taka requests someone else write the cheque. Aethelbert asks, if
there is a procedure to give money prior to purchase, especially
with larger budgets? Taka notes, the length of time it takes to
reconcile, it is not generally worth it (IE the rapier group gear not
being billed out for 2 months until it shipped). This process may be

done for the Armoured budget due to its size, and some of it can be directly billed to Ivar.

- i) Aethelbert asks, the deposit cheque for Skald the Hall is being mailed to him, what should he do with it? Taka notes to just bring it to fight practice.
